Dear Parents,

This week, we concluded our assembly series on the teachings of Jesus's *Sermon on the Mount*, focusing on the theme of rewards. Lastly, I'd like to extend my heartfelt congratulations to Rev. Nicholas Hutchinson, a current parent in our community, following his collation as Rector last night.
